Letter from the Board:

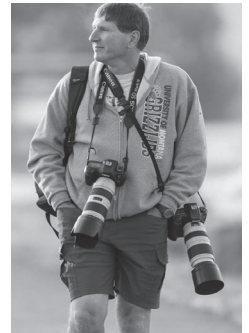
Welcome to Fall !

Fall is here, along with a busy schedule! First, thanks to the Cavallinis for housing the Hot Springs Artists Society's Photography Show. It ran into August at the On The Wall Gallery, at Wall Street Place in Hot Springs.

Joan Nevarez, our "Clay Lady", had a very busy summer, teaching pottery for kids at our town park. This class was sponsored by the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes. Now, with the sponsorship supplied by The Hot Springs Artists Society, Joan will continue to provide a Fall Pottery Class for Children. The classes will begin in October 4th and will last for six weeks. They will be held at our local Library on Fridays, every other week, from 12:30-2:30pm. The Water Story: Each year our "H" hill, that stands at the entrance to Hot Springs, is changed, according to the graduating High School Class for the year. In the year 2020, the H Hill will read H-20. What a great way to usher in a year of celebration of our water! The Hot Springs area was discovered long ago by our Native Tribes. They would come here to soak, rest and refresh. Likewise, as Homesteaders headed West, they found the Hot Springs and instantly utilized them for soaking, bathing and washing. In the 1920s-30s Hot Springs experienced a Hey-Day as soaking in our mineral water became a sought after beneficial medical treatment. One of the early monikers attached to Hot Springs was "Limp in--Hop Out". Later this was changed to an even more vivid rendition, "Limp In-Leap Out" We want to share our Healing Water with you and during this upcoming year of 2020, a dedicated steering committee is designing a calendar of events that feature "The Water".
